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IDOT: Ramp Closure & Lane Shift on NB Ramp to I-90/94 from Ontario for Construction of the Ohio Street Bridge to Begin Friday, October 4

Chicago- The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that weather permitting, construction of a new bridge and retaining wall for the Ohio Street Bridge Project will resume Friday, October 04, 2013.

Beginning at 10 p.m. Friday, October 04, 2013, the northbound ramp to I-90/94 from Ontario Street will be closed to motorists until 8 a.m. Sunday, October 6, 2013.

The Kennedy (I-90/94) reversible lanes to travel north on I-90/94 will be open to motorists, with the first available exit ramp at Addison Street.

The posted detour for trucks will be as followed: westbound on Ontario to eastbound I-90/94 Dan Ryan Expressway ramp, use exit ramp 52A for Taylor Street/ Roosevelt Road, travel south on Union Avenue to Roosevelt Road, turn left on Roosevelt Road, and turn left for entrance ramp to westbound I-90/94 to Kennedy Expressway.

Subsequent closure of other ramps will also take place for the completion of a new bridge, new retaining wall and newly align ramp to be built in the interchange. The anticipated completion date of this project is October 31, 2014.

Motorists can expect delays during times when the lane closures are in effect and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signing in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
