IDOT: Shoulder Closure & Lane Shift on SB Ramp to I-90/94 from Ontario For Construction of New Bridge and Retaining Wall to Begin Tuesday, September 3

Chicago- The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that weather permitting, construction of a new bridge and retaining wall for the Ohio Street Bridge Project will begin Monday, August 26, 2013.

In order to begin construction, preliminary work will begin along the Ohio Interchange to prepare the area. Daily shoulder closures will begin Monday, August 26, 2013, for preliminary pre-stage work.

Beginning Tuesday, September 3, 2013, the ramp from Ontario to SB I-90/94 left shoulder will be closed and the ramp lane shifted to allow the start of pre-stage work. Subsequent closure of other ramps will also take place for the completion of a new bridge, new retaining wall and newly align ramp to be built in the interchange. The anticipated completion date of this project is October 31, 2014.

Drivers are urged to pay close attention to the signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, be on the alert for workers and equipment, expect delays and be prepared to stop.
