IDOT: Ramp Closure of Ramp at I-94/103rd Street for Bridge Project to Begin Monday July 15

Chicago – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that weather permitting, repairs to the westbound ramp to I-94 from 103rd Street will begin Monday, July 15, 2013.

The construction consists of a new bridge deck and bearing replacement. The construction will include demolishing the existing concrete deck and parapet walls; along with the construction of a new concrete bridge deck, new parapet walls and new bearings on the ramp.

The anticipated time of shutdown for the ramp is 6 a.m. Monday. The contractor will have the detour in place before the shutdown takes place. The anticipated completion date for this project is October, 31, 2013.

Motorists can expect delays during times when the ramp closures are in effect and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to the signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
