**PEORIA** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that traffic on eastbound and westbound I-74 will be stopped for up to 20 minutes at US 150 in Morton starting at 7 p.m. Thursday, May 29<sup>th</sup> to allow utility crews to remove overhead power lines.

In addition, the right lane of eastbound I-74 will be closed between I-155 and Morton Avenue starting at 5:30 p.m. Thursday and continuing through Friday. This lane closure is necessary for crews to perform bridge joint repairs.

The overall project is the complete reconstruction of I-74 from Pleasant Hill Road to Morton Avenue in Tazewell County.

Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.
