The CAG:

- Is comprised of volunteers representing a variety of local interests
- Functions as a liaison between IDOT and the community
- Provides input to Project Study Group (PSG) on study elements such as:
 - Developing problem statement
 - Identifying community issues
 - Providing feedback on alternatives
- Will help generate interest in and knowledge about the study

CAG member roles:

- Share community information with the study team
- Share study information with the community
- Help ensure that community values and environment (context) are considered

CAG member responsibilities:

- Attend and participate in each CAG meeting
- Communicate in an open and honest fashion
- Respect the opinion of other CAG members
- Endorse the CSS process
- Always represent one's organization and community interest
- Consensus will be achieved on decisions; CAG process is not a vote
