

## 2017 Ethics in the Workplace Speakers



**Maggie Hickey** is the Acting Executive Inspector General for the Agencies of the Illinois Governor. She was nominated by Gov. Bruce Rauner in 2015. Before coming to the OEIG, she served the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Northern District of Illinois for over 10 years. From 2010-2015, she was the Executive Assistant United States Attorney (EAUSA), overseeing a staff of approximately 300 employees. Prior to her supervisory role, Maggie served as an Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) in the Criminal Division, Financial Crimes and Special Prosecution Section where she investigated and prosecuted a wide array of white collar

crimes, including health care fraud, mortgage fraud, and bankruptcy fraud. Maggie tried multiple cases to verdict and she also briefed and argued many appeals before the U.S. Court of Appeals.

Previously, she served as Chief of Staff to United States Senator Peter Fitzgerald. She began her career with the United States Senate serving as the Investigative Counsel for the Committee on Government Affairs. Prior to her service with the United States Senate, she was an Assistant United States Attorney in the Criminal Division for the Southern District of West Virginia. She began her legal career as an associate with the firm now called Reed Smith in Los Angeles, California. She currently serves on the board of the Constitutional Rights Foundation, Chicago.
