Bridge Inspections on Interstate 80 over the Des Plaines River

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daily lane closures are necessary for a routine bridge inspection on Interstate 80 over the Des Plaines River, in Joliet, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, April 25.

In order to complete the inspection, temporary lane closures will take place on Interstate 80 over the Des Plaines River, starting approximately two miles east of Larkin Avenue (Illinois 7). The closures will begin on westbound I-80 and switch to eastbound I-80, keeping at least two lanes open to traffic.

The inspections are expected to be completed by Saturday, May 7.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
