Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, construction work on Palmyra Road at the west edge of Dixon will begin on Tuesday, April 26, 2016. Civil Constructors is beginning the 1.5 mile project to improve Palmyra Road from IL Route 2 to west of Wolverine Road.

The \$248,489 contract includes milling off the top layer of the existing bituminous pavement and resurfacing the roadway. Drivers should be prepared to stop for flaggers who will be directing traffic past the work operations.

Motorists are asked to reduce speed when traveling through the construction area and to be alert for workers and slow moving construction vehicles. The project is expected to be completed by the end of the first week in May.
