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Multiple Road Closures

Livingston, Ford, Iroquois and Kankakee Counties

Ottawa, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that there will be multiple road closures affecting the Livingston, Ford, Iroquois, and Kankakee County area. Several contracts have been awarded to area contractors to replace structures in these counties.

A \$252,981 contract was awarded to H.J. Eppel & Company for a box culvert replacement on IL 116, 3 miles west of IL 47. A \$766,294 contract was awarded to Tobey's Construction & Cartage for removal of two bridges and replacing them with box culverts on IL 115, 0.9 miles and 1.7 miles north of Cabery. A \$419,628 contract was awarded to Stark Excavating for a box culvert replacement on IL 115, 4.1 miles south of US 24. A \$2,274,079 contract was awarded to Tobey's Construction & Cartage for multiple structure replacements on IL 54 from Gibson City to Melvin.

All projects will begin closures June 1st and will reopen when completed later in the summer. Motorists are urged to follow the posted detour routes.
