Location – IL 3 Ramps at I-270

The Illinois Department of Transportation has announced that partial ramp restrictions should be expected beginning Monday, August 8, 2016, weather permitting, at the following locations:

- The ramp from IL 3 southbound to I-270 westbound between the hours of 9:00 AM & 5:30 PM.
- The ramp from I-270 eastbound to IL 3 southbound between the hours of 7:00 AM & 3:30 PM.

These ramps will remain open during this work; however, partial ramp restrictions will be necessary. This work is necessary to paint navigation clearance gauges on the new Chain of Rocks Canal Structure and is expected to be completed by the end of August 2016. Ramps will remain open during this work; however, partial ramp lane closures will be necessary. Motorists are urged to be patient, reduce speed, obey all warning signs and allow extra time when traveling through the work zone.
