Edwardsville, IL

Location – Illinois Routes 143, 157 and 159 in the downtown area of Edwardsville

The Illinois Department of Transportation has announced that intermittent lane restrictions should be expected Sunday evenings through Thursday evenings during overnight hours from 6:00 PM to 6:00 AM beginning Sunday, March 27, 2016; weather permitting, at the following locations:

- IL 157 (West Street, St. Louis Street, West Vandalia Street and East Vandalia Street) between West Schwarz Street and Hillsboro Ave
- IL 143 (East Vandalia Street and Marine Road) between IL 157 and Schwarz Road
- IL 159 (North Main) between Vandalia Street intersection and East College Ave

This work is necessary to repair the existing pavement and construct a new asphalt overlay along the identified routes. This work is expected to be completed by July of this year.

The Department also asks that motorists abide by the posted “No Parking” signs used to close off parking lanes along these routes. Any vehicles parked in the identified “No Parking” zones will be towed at the owners expense so that work can continue. The Department asks that motorists be patient, reduce speed, obey all warning signs, and use additional caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone.
