Joe Page Bridge in Hardin

Location – The Joe Page Bridge which carries IL 16/100 across the Illinois River in Hardin

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that IL 16/100 will be restricted to one lane at the Joe Page Bridge on Monday, May 23, 2016, weather permitting. This work will take place between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM and is necessary to place supporting cables for the upcoming bridge repair project. Flaggers will be used to maintain two-way traffic across the bridge. This lane restriction will only be needed for one day.

Delays are expected. The Department advises the travelling public to follow all construction signs and drive with caution through the work zones.
