IL 267 in Greene/Jersey County

Location – IL 267 over Macoupin Creek at the Greene/Jersey County line

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that IL 267 will be restricted to one lane at Macoupin Creek during daylight hours beginning Monday, May 2, 2016, weather permitting. Intermittent daylight lane closures will be utilized until temporary traffic signals are installed at this location. Once the temporary traffic signals are installed, IL 267 will be restricted to one-lane and two-way traffic will be maintained through this area via the temporary traffic signals. This work is required in order to make repairs to the existing bridge and is expected to be completed by the end of August 2016.

The Department advises the traveling public to follow all construction signs and drive with caution through the work zones.
