Location – I-70 from I-55/70/270 interchange to 2.7 miles east of I-55/70/270 interchange

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that I-70 will be reduced to one lane in each direction from the I-55/70/270 interchange to 2.7 miles east of the I-55/70/270 interchange beginning Wednesday, August 17, 2016, weather permitting.

- All westbound lanes will be OPEN Monday through Thursday from 6:00 AM to 9:00 AM.
- All eastbound lanes will be OPEN Monday through Thursday from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM.
- All lanes will be OPEN Friday through Sunday.

This work is required to perform pavement repairs on this route and is expected to be completed by the middle of October.

Motorists are urged to use caution, obey all warning signs and allow extra time when traveling through the work zone.
