ON WATER MAIN

Collinsville, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that weather permitting, traffic will be reduced to one lane in both directions at the intersection of IL 100 and State Street in Alton, IL, in Madison County, starting at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, November 14, 2016, and continuing for five (5) days through Friday, November 18, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. The lane reduction is necessary to allow Illinois American Water Company to work on a water main.
