UPDATE - Press Release

IL 3 over Nine Mile Creek, south of Evansville, in Randolph County

Collinsville, Illinois – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces a lane restriction will be encountered on IL 3 at Nine Mile Creek, approximately 4 miles south of Evansville, in Randolph County. Weather permitting, the northbound lane of IL 3 will be closed to traffic on Monday, May 23, 2016. Temporary traffic signals will remain in place to guide traffic through the work zone, using the southbound lane. The work at this location was delayed by adverse weather, it is now anticipated this lane restriction will remain in place until Wednesday, May 25, 2016. The lane closure is needed to repair a bridge expansion joint.

It is anticipated this lane restriction will result in traffic delays, motorists are encouraged to consider alternate routes or allow additional travel time. Traffic control devices will be utilized during this lane restriction, to assist motorists making their way through the work zone. The Department asks that motorists be patient, slow down and use extreme caution when travelling through this work zone.
