LANE CLOSURE ON IL 3 IN EAST SAINT LOUIS NORTH OF SAUGET, IL, IN ST. CLAIR COUNTY

LANE CLOSURES ARE NECESSARY TO REHABILITATE TERMINAL RAILROAD'S OVERHEAD STRUCTURE.

Collinsville, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that weather permitting, one lane of both Southbound and Northbound IL 3 between I-64/I-55 and 8th Street in E. St. Louis, IL (north of Sauget), in St. Clair County will be closed on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 and Wednesday, November 9, 2016. Southbound lane closures will occur daily between 7:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M., Northbound lane closures will occur daily between 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.. The lane closures are necessary to allow the Terminal Railroad to rehabilitate their overhead railroad structure.

Traffic control will be in place to safely guide motorists around the lane closures. The Department asks that travelers be patient and use extra caution near and throughout the work area. For questions, please contact Rebecca Tharp at (618) 346-3197.
