**ILLINOIS ROUTE 13/153 (GRANT STREET) IN  
COULTERVILLE, IL, IN RANDOLPH COUNTY TO BE  
TEMPORARILY CLOSED**

**CLOSURE IS NECESSARY TO REHABILITATE  
UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY CROSSING**

Collinsville, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that weather permitting, Illinois Route 13/153 (Grant Street) between 11<sup>th</sup> Street and 10<sup>th</sup> Street in Coulterville, IL, in Randolph County will be closed beginning at 8:00 A.M. on Wednesday, December 27, 2017 and continuing for two (2) days through Thursday, December 28, 2017. The road closure is necessary to allow the Union Pacific Railroad Company to rehabilitate their crossing.

A marked detour will be in place to safely guide motorists around the closure. The Department asks that all motorists be patient, reduce speed, obey all warning signs, consider alternate routes, and use additional caution when traveling near this work zone. Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.
