Upcoming Lane Closures on Westbound I-55/70 and Ramp Closures on IL 203 in St. Clair County

COLLINSVILLE – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that westbound Interstate 55/70 will be reduced to one lane at Illinois 203 near East St. Louis beginning Friday night, November 3. The entrance ramps from Illinois 203 to westbound Interstate 55/70 will also be closed during this time.

Beginning at 10:00 PM on Friday night, the entrance ramps from Illinois 203 to westbound Interstate 55/70 will be closed in addition to the two right lane closures on westbound Interstate 55/70 at Illinois 203. The exit ramp from westbound Interstate 55/70 to westbound Interstate 70 will remain open at all times.

These closures are necessary to repair the bridge carrying Interstate 55/70 traffic over a drainage ditch. This work is expected to be completed by Saturday evening, November 4, weather permitting.

Delays are expected. Motorists are urged to reduce speed, obey all traffic control signage, allow extra time and use caution while driving through and near the work zone.

The contractor on this project is Keeley & Sons, Inc. of East St. Louis, Illinois.
