Ottawa, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that the IL 40-Union Pacific Railroad grade crossing south of Buda will be closed on Tuesday, November 28, 2017. IL 40 will be closed for approximately four days to allow the Union Pacific Railroad to repair their crossing. IL 40 traffic will proceed as follows:

IL 40 northbound traffic will proceed west on IL 93 to IL 91; thence continue west on IL 91 to US 34/IL 78; thence north on US 34/IL 78 to US 34; thence northeast on US 34 to US 6/US 34; thence east on US 6/US 34 back to IL 40.

IL 40 southbound traffic will proceed west on US 6/US 34; thence southwest on US 34 to IL 78; thence south on US 34/IL 78 to IL 91; thence east on IL 91 to IL 93; thence continue east on IL 93 back to IL 40.

Motorists are urged to use caution and expect delays while traveling the detour route.
