Full Closure of Algonquin Road in Des Plaines for UPRR Crossing Repairs

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that Algonquin Road will be closed at the Union Pacific Railroad crossing between S. Wolf Road and Mount Prospect Road, in Des Plaines, for crossing repairs, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, Oct. 16.

In order to complete the work, Algonquin Road will be fully closed at the railroad crossing located between S. Wolf Road and Mount Prospect Road. A posted detour will direct eastbound Algonquin Road traffic to go south on Mount Prospect Road, east on Oakton Street and north on Wolf Road to meet back with Algonquin Road. Westbound Algonquin Road traffic will take the reverse route.

The crossing repairs are expected to be completed on Wednesday, Oct. 18, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
