## **Full Closure of Lincoln Avenue in Dolton for Indiana Harbor Railroad Crossing Repairs**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that Lincoln Avenue will be closed at the Indiana Harbor Railroad crossing between 138<sup>th</sup> Street and 142<sup>nd</sup> Street, in Dolton, for crossing repairs, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, Oct. 16.

In order to complete the work, Lincoln Avenue will be fully closed at the railroad crossing located between 138<sup>th</sup> Street and 142<sup>nd</sup> Street. A posted detour will direct southbound Lincoln Avenue traffic to go west on 138<sup>th</sup> Street, south on Indiana Avenue and east on 142<sup>nd</sup> Street to meet back with Lincoln Avenue. Northbound Lincoln Avenue traffic will take the reverse route.

The crossing repairs are expected to be completed on Sunday, Oct. 22, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
