Full Closure of S. River Road in Des Plaines for UPRR Crossing Repairs

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that S. River Road will be closed at the Union Pacific Railroad crossing located south of Miner Street (U.S. 14), in Des Plaines, beginning, weather permitting, Thursday, Oct. 26. The closure is necessary to make repairs to the railroad crossing.

In order to complete the work, S. River Road will be fully closed at the railroad tracks south of Miner Street. A posted detour will direct northbound S. River Road traffic to go west on Algonquin Road, north on Mannheim Road/Lee Street (U.S. 12/45) and southeast on Miner Street to reconnect with S. River Road. Southbound S. River Road traffic should take the reverse route.

The crossing repairs will be completed on Friday, Oct. 27, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
