## **Bridge Inspections Saturday on the Bishop Ford over the Little Calumet River**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that lane closures will take place on the Bishop Ford Freeway (Interstate 94) over the Little Calumet River, weather permitting, Saturday, Oct. 28. The lane closures are necessary to perform a routine bridge inspection.

Starting at 7:30 a.m. Saturday, one lane will be closed in each direction on the structure that carries the Bishop Ford Freeway over the Little Calumet River, approximately one mile north of Illinois 83. Two lanes will remain open in each direction for the duration of the bridge inspection.

The lane closures will reopen by 2:30 p.m. Saturday, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
