## **Lane Closures Saturday at Harlem Avenue and Montrose Avenue for Pavement Repairs**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that lane closures will take place at Harlem Avenue (Illinois 43) and Montrose Avenue, in Chicago, beginning, weather permitting, Saturday, Oct. 28. The closures are required to perform pavement repairs.

In order to complete the repairs, a lane closure will take place on northbound Harlem Avenue at Montrose Avenue. Montrose Avenue also will be closed at the intersection.

The repairs are expected to be completed by 2 p.m. Saturday, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
