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Bridge Reconstruction Project on Greenwood Avenue over Amstutz Expressway in Waukegan

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a bridge replacement project will take place on the structure that carries Greenwood Avenue (Illinois 137) to Amstutz Expressway (Illinois 137), beginning, weather permitting, Monday, Oct. 30.

In order to complete the work, intermittent, daily lane closures will take place on Greenwood Avenue and the ramps to Amstutz Expressway.

The scope of the project includes removal of the existing Greenwood Avenue bridge over Amstutz Expressway, reconstruction of Greenwood Avenue on new embankment, as well as reconstruction of the expressway ramps that carry Greenwood Avenue traffic to Amstutz Expressway.

The overall project is expected to be completed in Fall 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
