Daily Lane Closures on U.S. 12 from Oak Street to Kuhn Road for Drainage Improvements

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that intermittent, daily lane closures will take place on U.S. 12 between Oak Street and Kuhn Road, in Fox Lake, Spring Grove, and Richmond, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, Oct. 30. The closures are necessary for a drainage improvement project.

In order to complete the work, daily lane and shoulder closures will take place on U.S. 12 from Oak Street to Kuhn Road.

The scope of the project includes culvert repair and installation of new drainage structures. The overall project is expected to be completed in Summer 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
