### Interstate 64 at IL Route 158, St. Clair County

Collinsville, Illinois – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces lane restrictions and ramp closures along WB Interstate 64 at IL Route 158 near Scott Air Force Base began at 9:00 AM on Tuesday, October 3, 2017 and should end by 3:30 PM on Friday, October 20, 2017. Weather permitting; the right lane of WB I-64 as well as the ramp from westbound I-64 to southbound IL 158 and from northbound IL 158 to WB I-64 will be closed.

The lane and ramp closures are needed to perform pavement maintenance at this location. IDOT Day Labor forces will make the needed repairs. Full access will be restored as soon as possible.

It is anticipated these restrictions and closures will result in significant traffic delays. Travel times will be affected on most roads in the vicinity of this closure. Motorists are encouraged to consider alternate routes or allow additional travel time in and around Scott Air Force Base. Additional traffic control devices will be utilized during these restrictions to assist motorists making their way through the work zone. The Department asks that motorists be patient, slow down and use extreme caution when travelling through this work zone.
