Ottawa, IL - The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that the US 52-Union Pacific Railroad grade crossing located south of Martinton will be closed on Monday, October 16, 2017. US 52 will be closed for approximately 12 days to allow the Union Pacific Railroad to rebuild their crossing. US 52 traffic will proceed as follows:

US 52 westbound traffic will proceed west on US 24 to IL 1; thence north on IL 1 back to US 52.

US 52 eastbound traffic will proceed south on IL 1 to US 24; thence east on US 24 back to US 52.

Motorists are urged to use caution and expect delays while traveling the detour route.
