I-64 – St. Clair County

Collinsville, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces lane restrictions will be encountered on I-64 at mile marker 27, near New Baden. The lane restrictions are needed for bridge deck repairs. Weather permitting, the lane restrictions will take place as follows:

The Eastbound right lane of I-64 will be closed at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 3, 2017 and will be re-opened to traffic on Thursday, October 5, 2017.

The Westbound right lane of I-64 will be closed at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 10, 2017 and will be re-opened to traffic on Thursday, October 12, 2017.

These lane restrictions may result in traffic delays, motorists are encouraged to consider alternate routes or expect longer travel times.

Traffic control devices will be utilized to assist motorists during these restrictions. The Department asks that motorists be patient, reduce speed, obey all warning signs, and use additional caution when traveling near this work zone.
