Lane closure planned April 9-12 for Interstate 74 in Vermilion County

TILTON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that traffic on westbound Interstate 74 between Tilton and Oakwood will be restricted to one lane beginning Monday, April 9.

Crews will be repairing the bridge over the Salt Fork Vermilion River. Work is expected to be completed by Thursday, April 12, weather permitting.

Delays are likely, so motorists should consider alternate routes. When driving through this and all work zones, motorists are reminded to reduce speeds and be alert for workers and machinery. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changing conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, restrain from using mobile devices, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
