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## **Weekend Lane Closures on the Inbound Kennedy, Ohio Street Ramp for Bridge Repair Project**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that nightly lane closures will take place on the inbound Kennedy Expressway (southbound Interstate 90/94) between North Avenue and Ohio Street, and the ramp from the inbound Kennedy to Ohio Street, in Chicago, beginning, weather permitting, Friday, April 13. The lane closures are necessary for an ongoing bridge repair project.

Starting at 10 p.m. Friday, the left lane will be closed on the Ohio Street ramp from the inbound Kennedy Expressway. The ramp will reopen to two lanes by 5 a.m. Monday, April 16.

Overnight lane closures will take place this weekend on the inbound Kennedy between North Avenue and Ohio Street, reducing the expressway to a single lane at times. The Kennedy Reversible lanes will be impacted by the nightly closures, as well as ramps from the southbound Kennedy to Augusta Boulevard, Ogden Avenue and Ohio Street.

The overall project consists of structural steel repairs on the inbound Ohio Street bridge over the Kennedy. It's expected to be completed by May 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
