Westbound Interstate 74 closed overnight April 5 between Galesburg and Woodhull

GALESBURG – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that westbound Interstate 74 will be closed for emergency repairs overnight Thursday, April 5, from the U.S. 34 interchange (exit 46) in Galesburg to the Illinois 17 interchange (exit 32) in Woodhull.

Beginning at 8 p.m. Thursday, all westbound traffic will use the following detour:

- U.S. 34 west (exit 46A) in Galesburg
- U.S. 150 north
- Illinois 17 east
- I-74 west in Woodhull

The work is expected to be completed and the interstate reopened by 6 a.m. Friday, April 6. Motorists are advised to be alert to detour signage and changing traffic conditions.
