## **Resurfacing of US 51 Business (Center St) and US 150 (Clinton St) in Bloomington**

**BLOOMINGTON** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work will begin April 9th on roadway improvements on US 51 Business (Center St) from Division St to Locust St and US 150 (Clinton St) from Empire St to N of Oakland Ave in Bloomington. The project includes patching, milling and resurfacing. Rowe Construction is the low bidder and will be performing the work on this \$1,100,000 project. At least one lane will remain open in each direction during the project duration. The project is expected to be completed by the end of May, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
