## **ADA improvements on U.S. 51 Business resume April 9**

**NORMAL** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that work will resume Monday, April 9, on improvements to U.S. 51 Business from Raab Road to Osage Street.

The project includes ADA improvements of sidewalks along U.S. 51 Business. At least one lane will remain open in each direction during the project, which is expected to be completed by the end of November, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, motorists should consider alternate routes. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changing conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
