Work scheduled to begin at 7:00 p.m. on April 23, 2018

Location – Illinois Route 121 starting at the south corporate limits of Mt. Zion and extending north to US Route 36.

The Illinois Department of Transportation has announced that beginning on Monday April 23, 2018 at 7:00 p.m work will begin on Illinois Route 121 from the south corporate limits of Mt. Zion and extending north to US Route 36. The work consists of pavement patching and will be completed between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Motorists are asked to slow down and use extra caution when traveling through the work zone.
