Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that construction work to replace the traffic signals at the intersection of US 67 with 92<sup>nd</sup> Avenue in Milan is nearing completion. The new traffic signals are expected to be operational this week.

Motorists should be alert for a new type of treatment of the left turn phasing. This installation features the Flashing Yellow Arrows. Left turning vehicles are permitted to turn on a flashing yellow arrow, but are required to yield to oncoming traffic.

Please use caution as lane workers will continue with removal of existing signal equipment and repair of island surfaces as weather permits.

Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.
