Resurfacing, Sidewalk Improvements on Illinois 56 in Hillside and Berkeley

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a road improvement project begins this week along Illinois 56 in Hillside and Berkeley. The overall improvements include resurfacing and pedestrian safety enhancements.

In order to complete the work, daytime lane closures will take place at the following locations:

- Butterfield Road (Illinois 56) between Cadwell Avenue and Washington Boulevard
- Washington Boulevard (Illinois 56) between Butterfield Road and Mannheim Road

The overall project consists of resurfacing, pavement patching, drainage work and landscaping. The project also includes sidewalk improvements, including curb and gutter, and pedestrian ramps compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

The project is expected to be completed in Fall 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
