## **Resurfacing, Pedestrian Ramp Improvements along Illinois 59 in Warrenville**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daytime lane closures will begin this week on Illinois 59 between Batavia Road and Ferry Road, in Warrenville. The lane closures are necessary for a resurfacing project and sidewalk improvements.

In order to complete the work, daily lane closures will take place at various locations along Illinois 59 from Batavia Road to Ferry Road.

The scope of the project consists of resurfacing and pavement patching, as well as pedestrian ramp improvements that comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

The overall project is expected to be completed in Fall 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
