Bridge Inspection, Lane Closures Sunday on Congress Parkway over Chicago River

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that temporary lane closures will take place on Congress Parkway (Interstate 290), in Chicago, beginning Sunday, July 8, weather permitting. The closures are necessary to perform routine bridge inspections on Congress Parkway over the Chicago River.

Beginning at 5:30 a.m. Sunday, inbound Congress Parkway will be reduced to one lane between Kennedy Expressway (Interstate 90/94) and Wells Street. All lanes are expected to reopen by 9:30 a.m.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
