## **Bridge Repairs on Illinois 64 over Fox River in St. Charles**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a bridge repair project will take place on the structure that carries Illinois 64 over the Fox River, in St. Charles, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, July 9.

In order to complete the bridge repairs, permanent lane closures will take place on Illinois 64, reducing the bridge to one lane in each direction for the duration of the project. Parking on the Illinois 64 bridge also will be prohibited.

The scope of the project consists of bridge deck repair and joint repairs. It is expected to be completed in Fall 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
