Daily Lane Closures for U.S. 45 Improvements between Grass Lake Road and Country Place

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daily lane closures will take place on U.S. 45 between Grass Lake Road and Country Place, in Old Mill Creek and Lindenhurst, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, July 9. The lane closures are necessary for a road improvement project on U.S. 45.

In order to complete the work, daytime lane closures will take place on U.S. 45 from Grass Lake Road and Country Place. Intermittent lane closures also will occur on Grass Lake Road.

The scope of the project consists of widening U.S. 45 to include two lanes in each direction with new curb, medians, guardrail and turn lanes. Work also will take place at the U.S. 45 and Grass Lake Road intersection. The project also consists of pedestrian improvements, including new sidewalk.

The overall project is expected to be completed in Fall 2019.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
