Nightly Lane Closures for Bridge Repairs on Southbound Interstate 94 over Interstate 57

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a bridge repair project will take place on the structure that carries Interstate 94 over Interstate 57, in Chicago, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, July 9. The bridge repair project will require nighttime lane closures on southbound Interstate 94.

In order to complete the work, nighttime lane closures will take place on southbound I-94 over I-57, reducing the southbound I-94 bridge to one lane.

The project is expected to be completed in August 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
