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Resurfacing, Sidewalk Improvements along Grand Avenue from U.S. 45 to the Tri State Tollway

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daily lane closures will take place on Grand Avenue (Illinois 132) between U.S. 45 and the Tri State Tollway (Interstate 94), in Gurnee and Lake Villa, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, July 16. The closures are necessary for resurfacing project which includes pedestrian safety upgrades along Grand Avenue.

In order to complete the work, daytime lane closures will take place on Grand Avenue between U.S. 45 and the Tri State Tollway. Intermittent nighttime lane closures also will be necessary as part of the project.

The scope of the project consists of resurfacing, pavement patching, and drainage repair. It will improve pedestrian safety with signal repairs, new sidewalks and upgraded pedestrian crossings compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

The overall project is expected to be completed in Fall 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
