Resurfacing, Sidewalk Improvements on Indiana Avenue between 135th Place to Sibley Boulevard

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daytime lane closures will take place on Indiana Avenue between 135th Place to Sibley Boulevard (Illinois 83), in Riverdale, Dolton, and South Holland, beginning, weather permitting, the week of July 9. The lane closures are necessary for a resurfacing and sidewalk improvement project.

In order to complete the work, daily lane closures will take place in both directions on Indiana Avenue from 135th Place to Sibley Boulevard.

The scope of the project consists of resurfacing, pavement patching and curb and gutter replacement. It also consists of pedestrian safety improvements, including new pedestrian ramps compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

The overall project is expected to be completed in Fall 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
