## **Resurfacing, Sidewalk Improvements on U.S. 30 in Joliet**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that intermittent lane closures will take place along U.S. 30 between Collins Street and Interstate 80, in Joliet, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, July 9. The lane closures are necessary for a resurfacing project and sidewalk improvements.

In order to complete the work, intermittent lane closures will take place on U.S. 30 from Collins Street to Interstate 80.

The scope of the project consists of resurfacing, pavement patching, and curb and gutter replacement. The project includes various pedestrian safety improvements, including new sidewalk and pedestrian ramps compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

The overall project is expected to be completed in Fall 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
