I-57 near Tuscola down to one lane starting July 9

TUSCOLA — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that traffic on northbound Interstate 57 near Tuscola will be restricted to one lane beginning Monday, July 9.

The restrictions are necessary so that crews can perform bridge repairs to the structure that carries I-57 over Scattering Fork. Work is expected to be completed by Thursday, July 26, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
