## **Resurfacing Project along Devon Avenue from the Des Plaines River to Canfield Avenue**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daily lane closures will take place along Devon Avenue from the Des Plaines River to Canfield Avenue, in Park Ridge and Chicago, for a resurfacing project, beginning, weather permitting, the week of June 25.

In order to complete the work, daytime lane closures will take place along Devon Avenue during non-peak travel times. Street parking also will be limited in active work areas.

The scope of the project includes resurfacing, pavement patching and repairs to curb and drainage structures. The project also includes sidewalk enhancements, providing pedestrians with updated street crossings compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

The overall project is expected to be completed in Fall 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
