Resurfacing Project along IL 176 in Island Lake/Wauconda

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daily lane and shoulder closures will take place along Illinois 176 between Roberts Road and Lark Road, in Island Lake and Wauconda, beginning, weather permitting, the week of June 25. The lane closures are necessary for resurfacing and sidewalk improvements.

In order to complete the work, daytime lane and shoulder closures will take place along Illinois 176 between Roberts Road and Lark Road.

The scope of the project consists of resurfacing, pavement patching and sidewalk improvements compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). The overall project is expected to be completed in Winter 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
