## **Resurfacing Project along IL 120 from U.S. 45 to I-94**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daily lane closures will take place along Illinois 120 between U.S. 45 and Interstate 94, in Grayslake, Gurnee, Libertyville and Waukegan, for a resurfacing project, beginning, weather permitting, Tuesday, June 26.

In order to complete the work, daytime lane closures will take place in both directions on Illinois 120 between U.S. 45 and I-94.

The scope of the project consists of resurfacing and installation of new shoulders. The overall project is expected to be completed in Fall of 2018.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
